





Our Story

Flexiteek was founded in 2000 with the aim of revolutionising the traditional marine decking market. Today, we've got boat owners and boat builders thinking about alternatives to endangered hardwoods like teak.

With our third generation of Flexiteek, we have changed things up for synthetic decking by using the very latest technology, like bio-attributed PVC, to produce the usual high-quality decking people have come to expect from us.

We have drawn on our founder's maritime experience and knowledge to inspire our products. We understand and have responded to the exacting demands of leading boat builders, to create beautifully engineered solutions.

Charity Strategy

Our charity strategy has always been focused on reducing the impact of our products by supporting long-term and meaningful projects that benefit endangered habitats, their biodiversity, and the wider communities that rely on them.

We currently support a number of local and global charities including World Land Trust.









FAQS

How much does Flexiteek weigh?

Flexiteek weighs 4.5kg per square metre (5mm option).

How long will it last?

Flexiteek has been in use for over 25 years now, and early decks are still in good condition. Obviously, it does depend on the maintenance and the level of use.

How does Flexiteek compare to its competitors?

Flexiteek is the only third generation synthetic decking on the market and offers a lighter and cooler alternative to others, with a wide range of realistic finishes and colours.

Does it get hot?

Flexiteek will get warm in hot climates but has been developed to reduce thermal transfer and cools up to 30% faster than traditional composite decking.

What are its non-slip properties?

Flexiteek has similar non-slip properties to teak and maintains excellent grip, even when wet.

How is Flexiteek made more sustainable?

Flexiteek is engineered using REACH-compliant, phthalate-free plasticisers with a low migratory performance. This makes Flexiteek 3 a trusted, safe and reliable product you can depend on.

What sort of maintenance is involved?

Flexiteek requires minimal maintenance. Just an occasional clean and if the grain starts to wear down, a quick resand will restore its fresh look and non-slip properties.

How is it designed?

Flexiteek can be designed to replicate a traditional teak deck or fabricated to a bespoke design for a modern or contemporary look.

How is Flexiteek put together?

Flexiteek is joined using vinyl welding techniques to ensure clean sealed joints.

What is a margin board?

A margin board is the framing around the planks and is normally a slightly wider section compared to the planks.

What is Flexiteek made from?

Flexiteek is made using a non-fossil PVC material called bio-attributed PVC. It's a material derived from managed pine tree locations and is every bit as durable as fossil-fuel based PVC but without the environmental dilemmas.



What advantages does Flexiteek have compared to real teak?

Flexiteek offers a real teak 'look' with added benefits of being lighter in weight with minimal maintenance requirements.



Can Flexiteek be used vertically?

Flexiteek is surface conforming, so it can be used on most angles and contours, both vertically and horizontally.



How much does it cost?

Flexiteek is priced based on square metreage and design. Quotes can be supplied from your local distributor on request.



What if I need a thicker product?

If you require, Flexiteek can be supplied on marine ply, GRP, laminate board or a foam layer of varying thickness to enable a snug fit to a recess or edge.



Can you re-sand it?

Flexiteek can be re-sanded by hand using 40 to 80 grit sandpaper and working in the direction of the grain. Do not use power sanders on Flexiteek.



What quantities can you buy Flexiteek in?

Flexiteek is supplied as bespoke decks or as panels to almost any size to suit your purpose.



Will it squash or buckle under pressure?

Flexiteek will compress if a fitting is through-bolted. We would recommend that anything bolted is placed on a solid packer such as Tufnol, UPVC, aluminium etc.



How easy is it to repair?

Your Flexiteek distributor is qualified to offer a repairing service. We'd always suggest using a Flexiteek expert to have this service done for you.



Can it be used for other applications than boats?

Yes, Flexiteek has been used for non-marine applications, such as domestic and commercial flooring.



Can Flexiteek stick to any surface?

Flexiteek adhesives will adhere to most surfaces successfully if the subsurface is painted. Often a 2-part epoxy can be used to create a suitable subsurface for the application of adhesives.



How do you clean Flexiteek?

We recommend using our cleaners, which have been fully tested for use with Flexiteek. A pressure washer also works well for a deep clean. Download our cleaning guide from our website at www.flexiteek.com.



Will it fade or change appearance?

Flexiteek will not fade or change; it may go a few tones darker after lengthy exposure to the elements. It can return to its new look by sanding the surface, just like with wood.
